# Turkey's indigenous car to boost GDP

### President Recep Tayyip Erdogan says Turkey's first indigenous automobile will hit roads in 2021

ANKARA - Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan said Tuesday that Turkey's first indigenous automobile would contribute 50 billion euros (\$58.7 billion) to the country's Gross Domestic Product (GDP). Erdogan said on Twitter that the electric car will also reduce Turkey's dependency on petroleum. "Our electric automobile that will

hit the roads in 2021 will contribute 50 billion euros to GDP, reducing oil dependency. It's time for a local car. It's time for Turkey," he said. Erdogan also shared a graphic that described how the indigenous automobile would contribute to Turkey's economy. Nearly 100 sub-sectors that will develop information, software and digital technologies will form and smart driving systems will reflect technologies of the future, the graphic said.

It also will contribute 7 billion euros (\$8.2 billion) to the current account deficit and 20,000 jobs.

The graphic also contained automotive industry export data which showed that exports rose from \$4.8 billion... MORE DETAILS

BERLIN - Turkey's most wanted coup suspect Adil Oksuz stayed at a small apartment in Berlin early this year idei the protection of Fetullah Terrorist Organization members, witnesses have told Anadolu Agency. Oksuz, a theology lecturer accused of masterminding Turkey's July 15, 2016, defeated coup, has been on the run for almost two years. Anadolu Agency correspondents digged out the flat in central Berlin, which was allegedly used by Oksuz and other FETO figures who fled from Turkey, since the defeated coup.
