## US coalition spokesman apologizes for Turkey tweet

WASHINGTON - The spokesman for the U.S.-led anti-Daesh coalition apologized Monday after posting a tweet critical of Turkey's military from an account believed to be sympathetic to the PKK terror group. "In my official capacity, I accidentally shared content that was insulting to our Coalition partner Turkey, a

key partner in the mission to defeat ISIS. I meant no disrespect," Col. Sean Ryan wrote on Twitter, referring to Daesh. "We have a duty to mutual security, and we are committed to defeating ISIS.
