Turkey's exports to Venezuela triple in 2018

IZMIR - Turkey's exports to Venezuela tripled in 2018 with a 223-percent rise compared to the previous year.

According to the data compiled by Anadolu Agency based on the Aegean Exporters Association, Turkey's exports to Venezuela reached \$120.8 million in 2018, versus \$37.4 million in 2017. Among the most exported products were pasta (\$27.9 million), sunflower oil

(\$13.6 million), wheat flour (\$7.9 million) and red lentil (\$5 million).

The close relation between Turkey's President Recep Tayyip Erdogan and his Venezuelan counterpart Nicolas Maduro had a direct effect on the trade, according to Mustafa Terci, the head of the Aegean Cereals, Pulses, Oil Seeds and Products Exporters Association. Sinn Fein say hard Brexit will trigger Irish unity vote

LONDON - The fate of a referendum on Irish unity is not tied to Brexit, but in the event of a no-deal Brexit with Britain crashing out of the European Union, the timing is right for the question to be put to the people, said the deputy leader of Irish nationalist party Sinn Fein. Speaking to Anadolu Agency, Michelle O'Neill said she would be "fearful

for the small element in society that made an attempt to bring us back to the past, but we have to stand very strong against that". "There is no room for
