Europe unwilling to reclaim Daesh fighters

ANKARA - European countries appear reluctant to reclaim home-grown Daesh militants fighting in Syria following a call by U.S. President Donald Trump for them to face justice in their home countries.

The YPG/PKK terrorist group, with U.S. assistance, has captured Daesh's last stronghold of the town of Bagoz in eastern Syria's Deir

Ez-Zor province. Last Saturday, Trump tweeted: "The United States is asking Britain, France, Germany and other European allies to take back over 800 ISIS fighters that we captured in Syria and put them on trial," using another abbreviation for the terror group.

ANKARA - PKK/KCK terrorism is intertwined with drug trafficking and other forms of organized crime, security reports obtained by Anadolu Agency show.

According to multiple reports and testimony by PKK terrorists captured by Turkish security forces, the smuggling and distribution of illicit drugs constitute a major economic activity for the group to finance its terrorist campaign. ANKARA - FETO, the group behind the 2016 defeated coup in Turkey, is pursuing a strategy of simply denying their many crimes in the hopes of escaping justice, said the Turkish justice minister on Wednesday. Speaking to Anadolu Agency, Abduhamit Gul said that the

Organization (FETO) deny their crimes "in line with orders" despite the evidence against them.
