

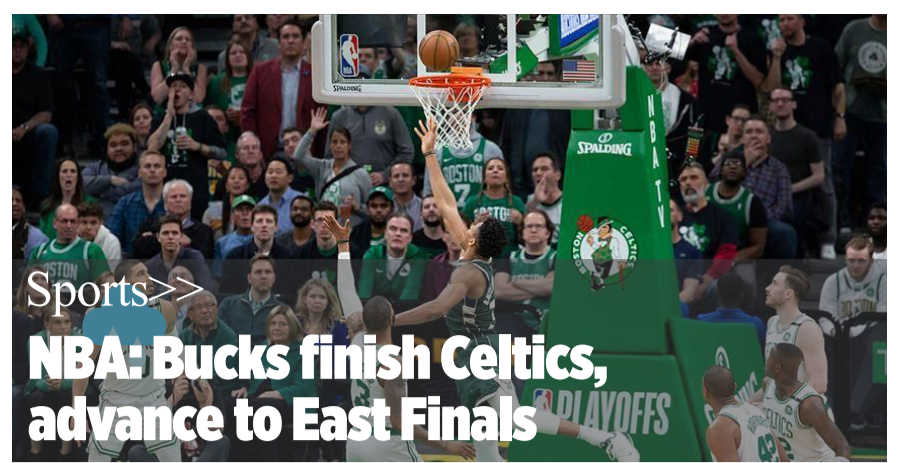

SARAJEVO - The European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) on Wednesday bought a \$100 million stake in a subsidiary of Turkish firm IC Ictas Energy. An agreement for the investment was signed during the EBRD annual meeting and business

forum in the Bosnian capital Sarajevo. Ictas Yenilebilir Enerji Yatirimlari, which has 10 hydropower plants, hopes to use the money to make an investment in wind farms and solar projects. 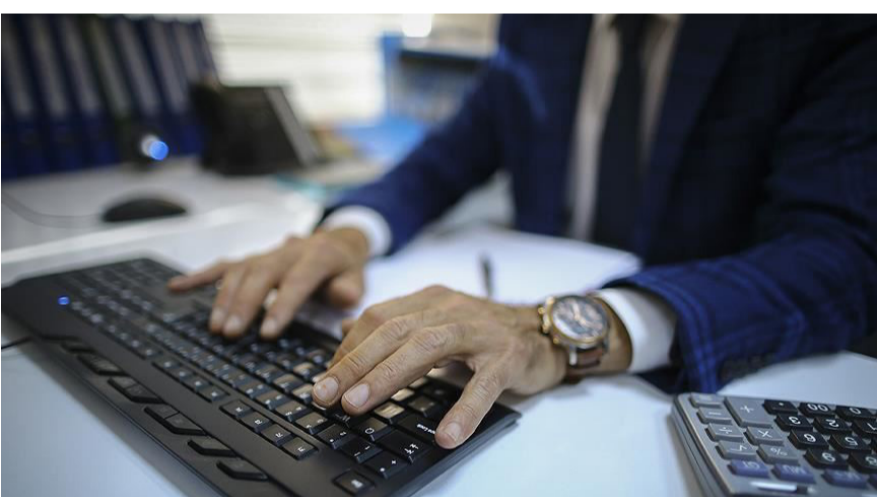
## Turkey urges US to respect Istanbul revote decision

## Ruling coalition resigns in Turkish Cyprus



ANKARA - The coalition government in the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) resigned on Thursday, according to local media. Premier and coalition leader Tufan Erhurman submitted the government's resignation to President Mustafa Akinci a day after Finance Minister Serdar Denktas resigned and the People's Party (HP) announced its withdrawal, Turkish Agency Cyprus reported.

Akinci, who accepted the resignation, asked Erhurman to continue as prime minister until a new government was formed. Following the snap general election on Jan. 7, 2018, the four-party coalition government consisting of Republican Turkish Party (CTP), the People's Party (HP), Communal Democracy Party (TDP) and Democratic Party (DP) was formed under leadership of Erhurman, who is the leader of the...
