# 600M Africans go without electricity

ADDIS ABABA - At least 600 million people in Africa lack access to electricity, according to an International Energy Agency (IEA) statement on Wednesday. “In Sub-Saharan Africa, three out of five people don’t have access to electricity,” Executive Director Fatih Birol said at the opening of the First Ministerial Forum of the African Union Commission and the IEA in the Ethiopian capital Addis Ababa.
