Research and development spending rises 21%

Turkey's central government research and development expenditures reach \$2.5B in 2018

ISTANBUL - Turkish central government's expenses to support research and development (R&D) activities jumped by 21.6% to reach 13 billion Turkish liras (\$2.49 billion) in 2018, the country's statistical authority announced on Friday.

Last year, the government's R&D spending were 0.35% of its GDP and 1.4% of its total budget expenditure, according to a statement issued by TurkStat. The country's indirect support for R&D activities also increased by 60% to 4.6 billion TL (\$882 million). The largest share of expenditures... MORE DETAILS

US Air Force warns against storming Nevada base



WASHINGTON - More than 1.7 million people have joined a Facebook event page calling for storming the top secret Area 51 military base in Nevada, sparking a warning from the U.S. Air Force.
